ABC NEW CANAAN A COMMUNITY SCHOOL PROGRAM

ABC New Canaan is an affiliate of A Better Chance National (ABC). Since 1963, ABC has been the preeminent resource for identifying, recruiting, educating, and developing leaders among underrepresented young people of color throughout the United States. ABC is the oldest and only national organization of its kind. It selects, prepares, and places gifted students of color in the country's most rigorous and prestigious independent day schools, boarding schools, and public schools.

ABC New Canaan is one of just 18 Community Public School Programs (CSP) within the ABC National umbrella, selected for its high-performing high school, dedicated community, and robust resources. **CSPs combine the best of both a boarding school and day school experience for students in a family environment.** Founded in 1974, ABC New Canaan is one of the oldest and most successful Community School Programs.

Our program welcomes scholars into the New Canaan community, where they:

*Attend our nationally ranked high school
and realize their academic potential*

*Live together family-style at our ABC House
in downtown New Canaan under the care
of our supportive resident director*

*Participate in all the athletic, artistic,
volunteer, and extracurricular activities
that New Canaan has to offer*

*Become a part of the local host family
and have a home away from home for their
four years in high school and beyond*

There are no fees to participate in our program - we cover the costs of virtually everything for our scholars for all four years, including:

- Housing and meals at the ABC House
- School lunch
- Weekly allowances for scholars (\$25 per week)
- Sports uniforms and equipment, including sneakers, cleats, etc.
- Extra clothing and toiletries as needed
- After-school activities both in and outside of New Canaan High School
- Music lessons, sports training, extra-curricular programs, field trips, youth mission trips, and much more
- Weekend activities
- Summer enrichment programs
- Tutors
- Standardized test prep courses
- Private college advising
- College tours and applications
- Driver's education for scholars in their hometowns
- Transportation to and from home for school breaks and long weekends
- **\$10,000 college scholarship (\$2,500 per year) for each graduating ABC New Canaan Scholar**

New Canaan High School (NCHS) — the heart of our scholars' academic experience — consistently ranks among the top public high schools in the nation, with its graduates attending some of the country's most prestigious colleges and universities, including University of Penn, Vanderbilt, Yale, Dartmouth, Boston College, NYU, and the University of Michigan.

Beyond academics, NCHS is known for its highly supportive faculty and abundant extracurricular activities, from championship-winning team sports to fine/performing arts, community service — and everything in between. NCHS's 46-acre campus contains new turf fields and athletic facilities, a state-of-the-art performance venue and library, and a newly restored planetarium.

In 2026-2027, NCHS has 59 athletic teams in 18 different sports, offering many opportunities for students at all levels. School teams have won state championships in football, lacrosse, soccer, basketball, swimming, golf, tennis, track and field, and cross country, producing numerous Division I and II NCAA and professional athletes. WELCOMING FACULTY

NCHS boasts exceptional teachers and administration who wholeheartedly support our program and our scholars. One of ABC New Canaan's board members sits on the faculty at NCHS and personally looks after the scholars at school to ensure their academic success and well-being.

GUIDANCE AND COLLEGE PREPAREDNESS

The counseling office provides services to all students in academic guidance, college preparation, and social and emotional development. Starting in freshman year, experienced guidance counselors work with students to plan a robust college-preparatory curriculum and a four-year academic plan to develop their highest academic potential and prepare them for college. Seniors also participate in a six-week internship program to gain real work experience in a field of their choosing.

NEW CANAAN

New Canaan is a vibrant, picturesque town with a welcoming personality. One of the few “walking towns” in Fairfield County, New Canaan has a population of 22,000 and a strong sense of town pride. It is located an hour outside NYC and is easily accessible by train. New Canaan is one of the safest towns in the state and an idyllic place to go to high school.

New Canaan’s charming downtown has a wide variety of restaurants, bakeries, shops, and much more. Best of all, **everything is located just outside of ABC House’s doors.** New Canaan also boasts nature preserves, parks, sports fields galore, churches of all denominations, art centers, ice skating, a 60,000 sq. foot YMCA (all ABC New Canaan scholars have memberships), and a brand new state-of-the-art library. There are endless activities and community-wide festivals, including the famous holiday stroll, block parties, and the annual May Fair Carnival.

For over 50 years, the town of New Canaan has championed the mission of ABC New Canaan and supported its scholars. Our program is funded 100% by the generosity of local residents, volunteers, foundations, businesses, New Canaan High School, and the Board of Education.





ABC HOUSE

ABC House is a warm and supportive place for our scholars to live, learn, grow, and form lifelong friendships. Welcoming and comfortable, ABC House is truly a family **HOME** for our scholars, resident director, and tutors. Our house is in the perfect in-town location, and the high school is just 1.4 miles away, making for a quick bus or bike ride.

A hub of activity and enrichment, ABC House features a great communal space downstairs, a comfortable living room with a TV, video games, and a piano. Our house also offers designated study areas and nightly tutoring, with each scholar having his own desk, Apple desktop, and a laptop from school. Our kitchen and dining room are bright and airy, where scholars and resident directors gather for dinner each night. Best of all, our wonderful cook, Margot, prepares a family-style meal that everyone shares together.

Upstairs are our scholars' bedrooms, which they decorate as their own, perfect for relaxing and recharging. We also have a 3rd-floor lounge. Our house accommodates up to eight scholars.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS & COLLEGE ADVISING

Academic success is our primary goal, and we support our scholars every step of the way. All scholars have a dedicated Academic Advisor and two Resident Tutors who track their academic growth daily through PowerSchool, which documents all academic activity from homework assignments and quizzes to tests and final exam scores. Scholars have mandatory study hall Monday through Thursday night from 7-9:30 p.m, supervised by our Resident Tutors who provide individualized support to help our scholars succeed in their classes.

As scholars enter their junior year, they receive intensive college access services and map out a two-year plan to gain admission to the college of their dreams. ABC New Canaan covers all costs associated with these services, including:

- › Enrolling scholars in SAT/ACT prep courses through the premier testing organization in the county.
- › Engaging an outside expert college advisor to guide our scholars through college application and selection process
- › Assisting our scholars and their families through the financial aid process to secure scholarships and assistance.
- › Bringing scholars on college tours and visits during the year

ABC New Canaan boasts a 100% graduation rate. Our scholars have attended prestigious colleges and universities, including Yale, Cornell, Boston College, NYU, Villanova, Georgetown, Denison, Northeastern, Boston University, Colgate, and Tufts.



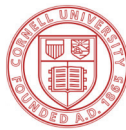

SOCIAL SUPPORT AND EMOTIONAL WELLNESS

Recognizing the challenges all high school students face, and the additional challenges of being a student of color in a predominately white environment, we provide our scholars a safe environment and essential social and emotional support. A licensed social worker meets weekly with our scholars in a group setting and individually to help them navigate the complexities of adolescence, cope with the pressures of academic and teenage life, make positive choices, and develop a strong sense of self.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

ABC New Canaan scholars participate in various sports and after-school activities to broaden their horizons, develop leadership, social, and athletic skills, and get involved at school and in the community. **Every day is filled with opportunities for exploration and personal development.** Our staff works with scholars to select these activities and support their participation. Scholars often begin a new sport or extracurricular activity without prior experience and emerge as enthusiastic and valuable contributors and teammates. From captains of Varsity sports teams and leading men in school plays to saxophone players in the school band and leaders in the local youth group, our scholars have done it all.

We also bring special speakers and host enrichment activities at ABC House—from cooking classes to managing finances.

SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

ABC New Canaan scholars participate in one or two summer enrichment programs to enhance their educational studies, pursue an interest, and maintain momentum between academic years. These programs also allow scholars to explore courses of potential interest in college and careers and provide exposure to a college environment. Our team works with scholars to find dynamic summer opportunities. Recent scholars have participated in a month-long program in Italy, one to three-week courses in STEM, business, medicine, and coding at major universities nationwide, and trained at sports academies.



HOST FAMILIES

A HOME AWAY FROM HOME

Our host families are a cornerstone of our program and essential members of our ABC family. Host families open their homes and hearts to our scholars, giving them **a home away from home** and helping them feel part of the New Canaan community. The boys spend every Sunday afternoon and night with their host families and one full weekend a month. The generous gift of time and care given by our host families is fundamental to the success of our program, and our scholars and their host families form lifelong friendships and bonds.

OUR ALUMNI & LIFE AFTER GRADUATION

When ABC New Canaan scholars graduate, they are academically prepared, intellectually curious, and ready for college. They leave New Canaan High School as well-rounded and confident leaders. Because of the different activities, programs, and experiences the boys have had during their four years at high school, they enter college with a wide variety of interests and skills to explore further.

The spirit of togetherness, bonding, and belonging the scholars have in the house stays with them always. They are brothers for life and part of the ABC family forever.

Our scholar graduates rise to become influential leaders in their careers and their communities, while staying proudly involved with ABC New Canaan. They actively support our scholars and often return to visit ABC House and their host families. Two of our alumni are on our Board of Directors.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

ABC New Canaan accepts students from throughout the East Coast and the Midwest with family incomes of less than \$200,000. You are eligible to apply if you:

Identify as a **person of color**: Black/African American, Asian American/Pacific Islander, Latino/Hispanic, Native American, or Multiracial

Are **male**. ABC New Canaan is a boys-only program.

Are a citizen or permanent resident of the **United States**

Are currently in **grade 8**

Consistently perform at or above grade level in **math and English**

Have an overall **academic average** of a B+ or better

Rank in the top **ten percent** of your class

Participate in **extracurricular** activities, both in and outside of school

Demonstrate **leadership potential** in school or through activities outside of school

Receive good teacher **recommendations**

Are of upstanding **character**

Thrive in a **group environment**

Are **eager to be part** of the New Canaan community and live at ABC House

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Report Card: Families will need to submit a current year/most recently issued report card

Transcript: A transcript showing the student's grade issued for the previous year

Test Scores: SSAT or ISEE test scores

Proof of Income: Families will need to submit one of the following:

- ▶ The first two pages of all 1040 forms for the family's most recent tax returns
- ▶ Any employer-issued W2s
- ▶ Any 1099s for miscellaneous income

Recommendations: Each student must submit a letter of recommendation from their guidance counselor, math and English language teachers.
